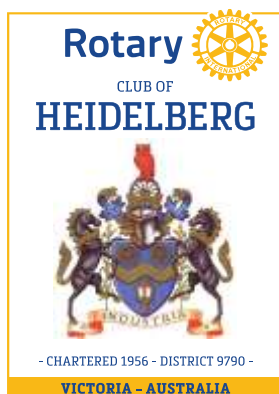

Except on the fourth Monday when we meet in the evening at 6.00pm.

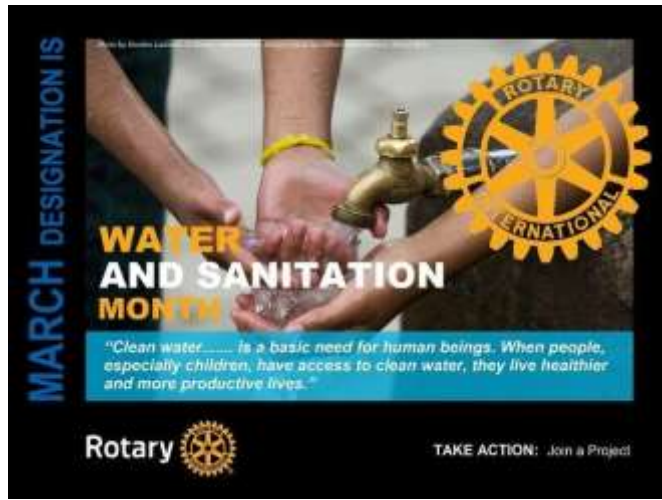
Our meetings over a light meal are informative and fun.

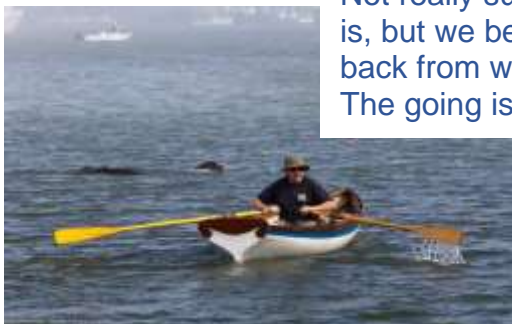

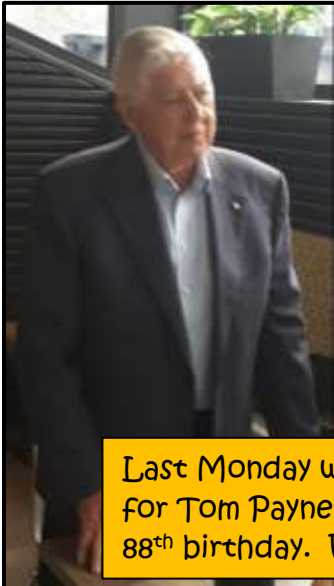

Our esteemed Editor is in Adelaide at the present but will be back soon to resume editorship of the COG as soon as he can get a flight home.



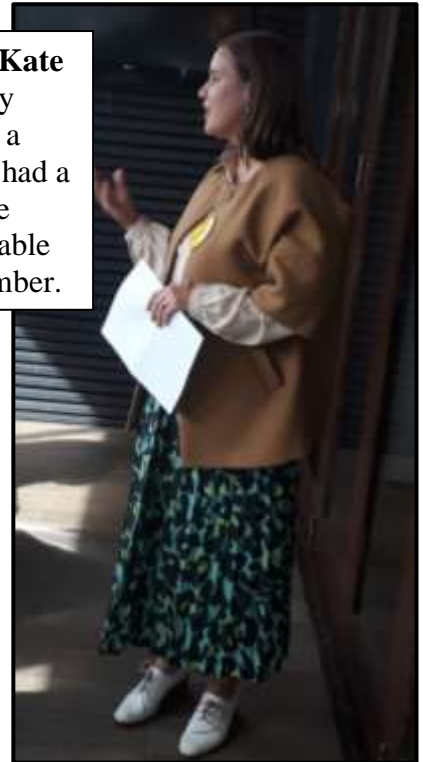
Following the 41 gun salute in Portsmouth this afternoon, President Macron of France has phoned Boris Johnson to surrender just in case.
